



#### Brief History of Motivation In Behavior Analysis

- Motivation in behavior analysis has frequently been confused with the role of reinforcement as a consequence.
- The clear identification of motivation as an antecedent environmental variable event began with the publication of B. F. Skinner's *Behavior of Organisms* (1938).
- Skinner included two chapters devoted to motivation
- He argued against the term "drive." Skinner asserted that, "The 'drive' is a hypothetical state interpolated between operation and behavior and is not actually required in a descriptive system." (p. 368)

# Applied Behavior Analysis Across the Spectrum



## Abstract

Applied behavior analysis (ABA) has been effective in treating and educating persons with severe impairments as well as persons who require treatment to produce near typical repertoires. ABA methods have been successful in overcoming the learning challenges of persons across the autism spectrum.

On the **first day** of this workshop, methods to **overcome the learning difficulties** of persons with moderate to severe disabilities will be presented. The discussion will focus on implementation of the methods outlined in the **Essential for Living**, an assessment and curriculum developed by Dr. Patrick McGreevy. Emphasis will be placed on the teaching of verbal skills and the “Essential Eight” skills which are necessary to ensure a productive and independent life of persons with severe impairments.

On the **second day** of the workshop, ABA methods that lead to **advanced language skills** necessary for socially appropriate and reciprocal conversational skills will be reviewed. Methods to teach **advanced manding** (requesting) and methods to **avoid the teaching of rote intraverbal** (conversational exchanges) will be presented.

The presentation of treatment methods will be illustrated with numerous video demonstrations.

Vincent J. Carbone, Ed.D is a **Board Certified Behavior Analyst-Doctorate** and **New York State Licensed Behavior Analyst**.

He received his graduate training in Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) at Drake University, Des Moines, Iowa, under the supervision of W. Scott Wood. He currently serves as an adjunct faculty member at Penn State University and teaches in the graduate programs in Behavior Analysis at the European Institute for the Study of Human Behavior, in Parma, Italy, and at the Medical School at the University of Salerno, Salerno, Italy.

Dr. Carbone's **behavior analytic research** has been published in several peer-reviewed journals including the Journal of Applied Behavior Analysis, The Analysis of Verbal Behavior, Behavior Modification, Research in Autism Spectrum Disorders and others. He has provided the requisite university training and supervision to hundreds of board certified behavior analysts in the U.S. and overseas.

Dr. Carbone is the 2017 **recipient** of the Jack Michael Outstanding Contributions in Verbal Behavior Award from the Association for Behavior Analysis International's Verbal Behavior Special Interest Group.

Currently, he serves as the **director of the Carbone Clinics** in New York, Boston, London (UK) and Dubai (UAE). All clinics provide behavior analytic consultation, training and therapeutic services to children with autism and developmental disabilities.
